1. Principles for processing personal data

My principles for processing personal data are:

- Fairness and lawfulness. When I process personal data, the individual rights of the Data Subjects must be protected. All personal data must be collected and processed in a legal and fair manner.
- Restricted to a specific purpose. The personal data of Data Subject must be processed only for specific purposes.
- Transparency. The Data Subject must be informed of how his/her data is being collected, processed and used.

2. What personal data I collect and process

I collect several different types of personal data for various purposes. Personal Data may include, but is not limited to:

- Email address
- First name and last name
- Phone number
- Address and Postal code

3. How I use the personal data

I use the collected personal data for various purposes:

- To provide you with services
- To notify you about changes to my services and/or products
- To provide customer support
- To gather analysis or valuable information so that I can improve my services
- To detect, prevent and address technical issues

4. Legal basis for collecting and processing personal data

My legal basis for collecting and using the personal data described in this Data Protection Policy depends on the personal data I collect and the specific context in which I collect the information:

- I need to perform a contract with you
- You have given me permission to do so
- Processing your personal data is in my legitimate interests
- I need to comply with the law

5. Retention of personal data

- I will retain your personal information only for as long as is necessary for the purposes set out in this Data Protection Policy.
- I will retain and use your information to the extent necessary to comply with my legal obligations, resolve disputes, and enforce my policies.

6. Data protection rights

If you are a resident of the European Economic Area (EEA), you have certain data protection rights. If you wish to be informed what personal data I hold about you and if you want it to be removed from my systems, please contact me – details above.

In certain circumstances, you have the following data protection rights:

- The right to access, update or to delete the information we have on you
- The right of rectification
- The right to object
- The right of restriction
- The right to data portability
- The right to withdraw consent
